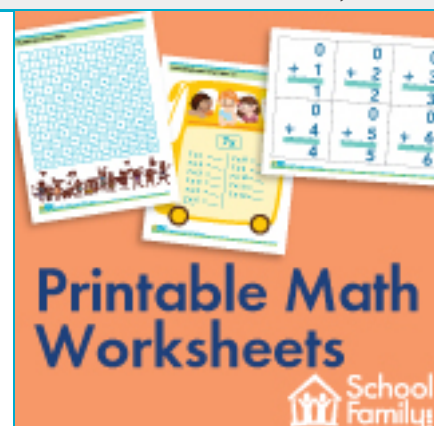


KINDIE HALLOWEEN PARTY

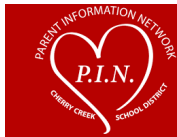

WHEN: Tuesday, October 4th, 9:15AM-11:15AM and Wednesday, October 5th, 7PM-8:30PM

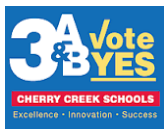
